Here are just a few special notes about the coming spring half term 2018.

The children are making lovely progress in their learning and this is evident in their **learning journeys**. Thank you so much for all your contributions too and all the informal conversations you have with the team about your child's learning. We love sharing in your child's learning with you both at home and at nursery. Finding out they are fascinated by something at home and being able to see how this continues at nursery enables us all to use this information to develop each individual child's learning so we can work together with you to support your child's learning and development.

We are continuing to develop and deepen our understanding and provision for young children's learning by ensuring that they have real physical learning adventures and challenges. Research shows that children who experience challenges and become risk competent show the best attitudes to learning – such as high levels of engagement, motivation to want to learn and being able to think about and use their own ideas.

We are also developing our understanding of the importance of sensory development. We are particularly focussing on the sense of balance and the sense of proprioception often referred to as the 2 extra senses. Please ask the staff for more information.
