Please support your child to take off their coats and shoes when they come into nursery and to put their coats and shoes back on when you collect them. All the time and support you can give your child in developing their independence really helps their confidence and self-help skills.
- We are currently preparing our garden space for planting – if anyone has spare seeds, bulbs or plants please let us know and we will gladly make use of them.
- Please ensure if you have had a new phone number that you have informed staff on reception. **It is essential for safeguarding** that we can contact you **at all times** when your child is at Windsor if we need to. Also please contact us to let us know if your child is unwell and unable to attend nursery. You can telephone, email us or ask another parent to pass on a message.
