OPEN SESSIONS – Thank you very much to everyone who attended our parent's sessions. We hope you found it useful to discuss your child, how they are progressing and how we can best work together to develop your child's learning. READING & WRITING –Look out for your child's next set of rhymes in their learning journey which we are learning in nursery. To help develop your child's reading and writing we encourage each child to register and sign themselves in. Please take a little time just to support them doing this at the start of the session. If you would like some additional information about how to sound out letters or letter formation please ask your child's special teacher for a help sheet

GROWING UP & MOVING ON- Children who will be moving to reception in September will have received information via email or letter about their school place. Children move on to a range of different schools and we spend time preparing the children for the move by talking with them about who else from nursery might be going to their school and inviting the schools that the children are moving to, to come and meet the children at nursery. Take a look at our transition board to see who is going to the same school as your child.

All schools will offer you a parent's visit before your child moves on. We will support you and your child in this process and if you have any questions please feel free to speak to Jill

PHONE NUMBERS- It is vital for safeguarding that we can contact you/ carer at all times while your child is at nursery. If you change your phone number please inform Clare or Becky at reception who will be able to update your records.

We monitor the children's attendance carefully and are delighted in how supportive you are as parents in ensuring the children attend regularly. It helps as part of our safeguarding processes and we have evidence that children who attend regularly make the best progress. We are also aware that young children are more susceptible to illnesses so please let us know if they are unwell and are unable to attend nursery.
